## CHARDONNAY

Since 1980 the Hahn family has cultivated their hillside vineyards in Monterey County. Today, Hahn Winery remains committed to crafting rich, supple wines which consistently over deliver on quality.

**WINEMAKING NOTES:** The grapes for this wine were grown primarily in the Arroyo Seco appellation of Monterey County, which sits on a gravelly alluvial plain beneath the Santa Lucia mountain range. Cool winds from Monterey Bay ensure gradual ripening and the development of vibrant flavors. The gravelly soils of the appellation allow excellent drainage, enhancing flavor intensity while maintaining crisp acidity.

**TASTING NOTES:** Initial scents of pineapple and mango give way to aromas of pear and vanilla. A rich mouthfeel shows flavors of banana, baked apples and toffee. A touch of acidity balances a note of sweet butter on the crisp finish.

**FOOD PAIRINGS:** Grilled Sea Bass, Chicken breast with lemon, Caesar salad.
