



## CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2011 RESERVA TERROIR

ORIGIN DENOMINATION:	Colchagua Valley, <i>Los Lingues Vineyard</i>
VARIETY:	100% Cabernet Sauvignon
HARVEST DATE:	Mid April
AGEING:	80% of the wine in French oak barrels of different uses for 9 months
CLOSURES AVAILABLE:	Natural cork
STORING POTENTIAL:	4 to 6 years in optimum conditions
FORMATS:	375 ml, 750 ml, Magnum
ANNUAL PRODUCTION:	20.000 cases

### TASTING NOTES

The wine has a nice deep ruby red colour. Ripe red fruit notes with some smoky and chocolate hints from its time in oak barrels. Good volume on palate, with tannins that support its firm structure.

≈ It is ideal for pairing with red meats, pasta or just enjoying by its own.

Serve between 16° - 18°C.

### VITICULTURE

85% of the grapes were produced in Colchagua Valley, while the other 15% came from Maule. Colchagua gives red fruit character with some soft tannins, while Maule delivers good acidity level and a bigger structure to the blend.
