Wynns Coonawarra Estate was founded by Scottish pioneer, John Riddoch in 1891. He recognizes the potential of a small strip of red soil, the terra rossa, in the far south east of South Australia, which is now some of the most expensive viticulture land in Australia. Today Wynns is the region's pre-eminent wine producer and largest single vineyard holder with the best and longest established vineyard sites in the Coonawarra. Its wines are regarded as benchmarks for the districts, lauded for their consistent quality and depth of flavor.

Riesling 2011

Vibrant straw with green hues. Distinctive lemon sherbet with citrus blossom notes. On the palate, the long and persistent flavours of muddled lemon and lime are framed by lively acidity and a touch of chalky minerality.

Chardonnay 2011

Elegant bright citrus fruits are enhanced by delicate mineral notes, combined with subtle nectarine and white peach. Well integrated cashew notes are in the background from light French oak maturation. An amalgam of stone fruits provides great depth and complexity while subtle citrus notes adds length, creating a seamless palate.

John Riddoch 2009 (Limited Availability)*

Deep red/black in colour, suggesting its strength and intensity. Aromas of classic Coonawarra Cabernet - dark berries, cassis and violets. Freshly crushed mint and some lavender florals enter the fray. Layers of dark plum and cassis are framed by dried rosemary, with lovely oak integration exhibiting smoked meats and spice. Fine grained tannins are tight and long, suggesting excellent cellaring potential.

Michael Shiraz 2009 (Limited Availability)*

Deep red with a vibrant purple hue. Immediately aromatic and revealing, the warmer 2005 vintage is apparent on the nose with lovely ripe blueberry fruit, while still showing regional pepper and bay leaf aromas. An abundance of raspberry fruit holds the mid-palate with juicy viscosity. Darker plum adds to the wine's depth, with excellent oak integration that highlights ripe berry fruit flavours, while adding length on the palate with firm, chalky tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon 2009/10

The wine displays cassis and red berry fruits with dark chocolate and coffee emerging. Slight aeration reveals concentrated berries with hints of floral and creamy oak, riper fruit flavours with velvety tannin, and a long palate. A full-bodied wine, combining defined fruit, clean acidity and a persistent finish.

Gable's Cabernet Shiraz 2010

Deep red with garnet edges. Lifted plums and dark berry fruit, backed by subtle mint and cedary oak. Mocha-like oak fills out the seams finishing with fine grained tannin.

Cabernet / Shiraz / Merlot 2010

Dark opaque hue with bright crimson rim. This is a generous wine showing ripe cassis, bright plums and brambly fruits. The blend of varieties melds to produce a supple and seamless palate profile. It has fine grained, well integrated tannin and a lingering finish that is well supported by creamy, stylish oak.

Shiraz 2010/11

Vibrant deep red with purple hue. On the nose there are lifted red cherries and wild berries, with some sweet spice. The palate is rich and spicy, with red berry fruit and a touch of nutmeg. The fruit is well supported by ripe soft tannin which combine to add lovely length on the back of the palate.
